

Stephens Lake Park Riechmann Pavilion

New Indoor Pavilion Available to Rent for Group Gatherings!

As part of the Columbia Parks and Recreation master plan for Stephens Lake Park, the Clarence Riechmann (pronounced Rickman) Indoor Pavilion will be used to house the Camp Adventure summer day camp, recreation classes and will also be available to rent for group gatherings or business events. This beautiful one-story building, constructed out of red cedar timbers, sits on the north east side of the park on a hilltop overlooking the park and lake. The 2,000-square-foot main room has a vaulted ceiling, and offers a scenic view through the large wall of windows, making it an ideal location for weddings, receptions, reunions, company meetings or group gatherings (maximum of 150).



Amenities include: tables, chairs, lockable closet, restrooms and a “warming” kitchen complete with oven/stove, microwave, and refrigerator with freezer. The building grounds include a playground and an open space suitable for outdoor activities, tents, and grilling.
